MINISTERS' CONFERENCE OF WINSTON-SALEM AND VICINITY CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

PREAMBLE

In order to create and maintain a closer Christian fellowship with each other, to find the best solution for common problems and the most workable approach to worthy concerns, and to advance the general interest of the cause of Christ through the ministers, pastors, and laity of area churches, we the ministers, pastors, and laypersons hereby unite ourselves into a Ministers' Conference of Winston-Salem and Vicinity to pursue these objectives.

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of this body shall be the Ministers' Conference of Winston-Salem and Vicinity.

ARTICLE II – MEMBERSHIP

Section 1: This body shall be composed of ordained, licensed, Christian ministers and laypersons from Winston-Salem and vicinity. The Conference is an inclusive ecumenical and interfaith Christian body representative of denominations and gender.

Section 2: Members shall consist of ministers and laypersons whose religious work and leadership would warrant membership in this body (from Winston-Salem, vicinity and neighboring cities). Only Active Members shall be entitled to vote on the business of the conference, hold elected office in the conference, or serve as the chair of one of the General Committees. Active members are defined as those who have a) paid their annual dues by the last Tuesday of September each year, and b) participated regularly in the conference; regular participation in the conference is defined as attendance at ¹/₃ of the meetings that have been held thru the last Tuesday in October. A list of Active Members shall be maintained by the Recording Secretary and Assistant Recording Secretary and updated quarterly. Attendance will be taken at each meeting of the Conference.

The officers of this body shall be president, first vice-president, second vice-president, recording secretary, assistant recording secretary, treasurer, chaplain, and parliamentarian. Only ordained, licensed, Christian ministers who are Active Members are eligible to serve as officers of this body.

This body shall adopt *Roberts Rules of Order* as its parliamentary guide Bylaws and Constitution of MCWS&V Revised by the Bylaws Committee 06/01/2018 Bylaws and Constitution with Amendments Approved by the MCWS&V Body Present 09/18/2018
